Through participating school districts, StoryArk offers what we call our "Absent Narratives Project." We seek to create a relevant and accessible arts experience for students whose voices are underrepresented and to remove barriers that keep their absent narratives from being heard. We believe stories provide context and meaning for our lives and can inspire us to think more critically about how we fit into the world and ultimately about what responsibilities we have to each other. We strive to elevate youth voice and leadership in order to improve and ensure inclusiveness in our schools and our community.

During StoryArk's creative process, students explore identity and produce podcasts, short films, music lyrics and a literary magazine that features prose, poetry and visual arts. Youth share these stories with themselves and with the general public, and by doing so, promote understanding and increase empathy for the student experience.
